On June 26-27<sup>th</sup>, my family accompanied me to Life Point Community Church (Fuquay, NC). Michael Horton as Associate Pastor. Michael served with CCM as a teenager several years ago. He is also the son of our former pastor, David Horton. What a blessing it will be to minister with Michael again.
